4 First aid measures

- **General information:** If symptoms persist or in case of doubt seek medical advice.
- **After inhalation:** Supply fresh air; consult doctor in case of complaints.

7 Handling and storage

Ensure good ventilation/exhaustion at the workplace.
Prevent formation of dust.
Any deposit of dust which cannot be avoided must be regularly removed.

Avoid inhalation of vapours formed by heated product.

8 Exposure controls and personal protection

Install appropriate mechanical ventilation.

Observe general threshold limit for dust.

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- **Personal protective equipment**
- **General protective and hygienic measures:**
 The usual precautionary measures should be adhered to when handling chemicals.
 Keep away from foodstuffs, beverages and feed.
 Immediately remove all soiled and contaminated clothing
 Wash hands before breaks and at the end of work.
 Vacuum clean contaminated clothing. Do not blow or brush off contamination.
 Use skin protection cream for skin protection.
- **Breathing equipment:**
 Not necessary if room is well-ventilated.
 Short term filter device:
 Filter P1.
 If vapors are formed use suitable respiratory protective device
- **Protection of hands:**
 Protective gloves.
 To avoid skin problems reduce the wearing of gloves to the required minimum.
 Preventive skin protection by use of skin-protecting agents is recommended.
 After use of gloves apply skin-cleaning agents and skin cosmetics.
- **Material of gloves:**
 The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer.
 Adjust selection of glove material to the other substances used.
 For undissolved solid substances following materials may be suitable:
 Nitrile rubber, NBR
 Butyl rubber, BR
 Polychloroprene rubber (CR)
 Fluorocarbon rubber (FKM)
- **Penetration time of glove material:**
 The exact break-through time has to be found out by the manufacturer of the protective gloves and has to be observed.
- **Eye protection:** At formation of dust or insufficient ventilation: Tightly sealed goggles.
- **Body protection:** Protective work clothing.

 To avoid thermal decomposition do not overheat.
 At temperatures above 280° C ammonia is formed.

- **Dangerous reactions:** Strong exothermic reaction with above-mentioned substances.

 In the case of fire or at high temperatures the formation of the following decomposition products is possible.
